

**Notice is hereby given pursuant to Article 7, Section 23(C) of the Louisiana Constitution and R.S. 47:1705(B) that a public hearing of City of Springhill of the Parish of Webster will be held at the regular meeting place, City Hall, located at, 101 Machen Dr, Springhill, Louisiana, on Monday, August 11, 2025 at 5:00 p.m. to consider levying additional or increased millage rates without further voter approval or adopting the adjusted millage rate after reassessment and rolling forward to rates not to exceed the prior year's maximum. The estimated amount of tax revenues to be collected for General Alimony in the next tax year from the increased millage is \$201,105, and the amount of increase in taxes attributable to the millage increase is \$12,537.**

Publication Requirements:

1. Publish 2x in the official journal, The Springhill Press, and in a newspaper with a larger circulation count if there is one?
  - a. Springhill Press – June 26<sup>th</sup> & July 3<sup>rd</sup>
  - b. Shreveport Times – June 26<sup>th</sup> & July 3<sup>rd</sup>
2. Placement in a prominent section (body of the paper)
3. Placement can NOT be in the classified advertisement, public notice, or legal sections of the newspaper.
4. Formatted in a box with a bolded outline
5. A size of not less than 2 inches by 4 inches (request a 3x5)
6. Print in bold face type
7. Newspapers must supply the full, and complete tear sheets from both publishing dates, and affidavit of publishing.

Website Posting Requirements:

Per R.S. 47:1705(B)(2)(c)

1. On the first day of publication, occurring no less than 30 days before the public hearing date, the tax recipient body must post the notice of public hearing on their internet website if there is one.
  - Post – June 26, 2025
2. The internet posting shall remain active until action has been taken to approve or disapprove or action has been abandoned on the proposed millage increase.
  - Remove – August 12, 2025

Per R.S. 47:1705(B)(2)(c)(i)

1. For the purpose of the internet publication only, the notice shall contain a recitation of the current budget of the taxing authority.
  - Attach budget to posting – June 26, 2025
